#### **Old Business**

- Meeting Minutes
  - o June 28, 2011 Board Meeting Minutes
    - The board voted unanimously to approve the minutes as amended.
- Traffic Circle at Greenway Terrace/Pennsylvania
  - The driver who damaged the circle has paid for the cost of repairs, so this item is resolved.
- Park/Island Maintenance
  - We have budgeted to pay for 10 hours of watering per month, but with the extreme heat we've experienced, it is not enough, and there is some concern that the landscaping contractor isn't watering that much. The circle at Greenway/Penn. in particular looks neglected and as though it needs weeding. Terry has been in touch with Atlas but is frustrated with their lack of responsiveness. He is planning on meeting with them in September and at that time may discuss using some native species in these common areas that ideally can withstand the harsh climatic conditions. The Board also discussed including landscaping at the Meyer Columns as a future budget item.
- Hours sign at Strawn Park
  - o Gina has spoken with Odegard Signs and is waiting for them to give her quotes on some specific designs.
- Popsicle Parade Recap
  - The parade was a success. A few tweaks for next year are in order: per Terry, we need more ice next time, wipes, water for dogs, and a sign to acknowledge the popsicle donors. Nametags for Board members might be a good idea also. In January, we should revisit the idea of ordering a few more signs. Katie Allison provided the patriotic music.
- Rain Garden
  - The Greenway Terrace/Pennsylvania traffic circle would be an ideal spot for a first try at a rain garden. Philip Bouillette will check with a landscape

architect he knows to see if he has any advice concerning getting started with a rain garden.

#### August Newsletter

- We will solicit neighbors' feedback on rain gardens as well as on a neighborhood-wide leaf-removal event.
- It will also include picnic and parade photos, as well as an article about Nourished by Neighbors.

#### • Neighborhood Garage Sale
