April 16, 2018 – 6:15 PM at Scott's home – 418 W. Meyer

- 1. Call to order Quorum present.
- 2. Review / approve agenda Clem, motions to approve agenda as written.
- 3. Open issues:
 - Review / approve minutes from March 2018 GHFA meeting. Motion to approve and can be sent to Patty at HA-KC for web posting.

4. New business:

a. Finance update:

- i. Treasure update GFHA / GFNCID large payment for statue restoration pending withdraw from GFHA.
- ii. #160 GFHA budget for FY18/19 \$5,425.78. Balance from FY17/18 +\$3453.46 MOTION to Approve GFHA FY18/19 Annual Budget: APPROVED
- iii. GFNCID shows \$5k over budget but that due to major maintenance issues, will balance by end of fiscal year April 2018.
- iv. FY17/18 final \$12,782.88
- v. FY18/19 budget is \$54,880. \$4,000 (5%) budgeted for PIAC match

b. Newsletter - Next Issue May 2018 - Joe / Scott

- i. 2018 newsletter issues are: (3) publications sent out in JAN / MAY / SEPT.
- ii. Annual yard sale Sat. May 12, 2018 (Neighborhoods Meyer Oak Gardens, Armour Hills, Greenway)
- iii. Annual Picnic Date: Sat. June 2, 2018 from 5-7 PM. Budget \$350.00, grill brats / hot dogs, water / tea provided. Residents bring side dish or dessert, or any favorite beverage.
 - 1. Joe suggested acoustical guitar player \$200 from 6-7PM. MOTION to approve \$200 to fund Jay Eudaly to play the picnic. APPROVED
 - 2. Joe has secured Scimeca's Italian sausages to cater.
 - 3. Ben and Laura have created a flyer to be sent with the newsletter.
- iv. Popsicle Parade Date: 7/4/18 at 10 AM, 635 W Meyer. New owner has been contacted
 - 1. Ask Brookside market for 400 popsicles in advance, 2 coolers, and trash bags for cleanup.- Kurt will contact.

c. Centennial Note

- i. Bronze Plaque details 100 years 1917-2017, cost review.
 - 1. All Star Awards 2@\$528, 2@ \$306= \$1,668 total cost. Approved March. Plaques have been ordered, waiting to arrive. Clem will provide tax exempt document.

d. Security Updates - Joe

- i. Sargent Hanriot, KCPD attended Board meeting and shared updates with the board. Security presence and addressing suspicious activity in GFHA is often enough to deter property crime.
- ii. It's important for neighbors to contact 911 whenever they see suspicious activity.
- iii. Increasing hourly rate to \$40/hour has made it much easier to recruit off duty officers to patrol.
- iv. Neighbors are encouraged to register personal cameras (Ring, etc), with KCPD. Information should be included in an upcoming MailChimp to GFHA members.
- v. Any incidents in area recently? Nothing to report.

e. Communication - MailChimp

i. Topics to send – Brookside Art Annual; Neighborhood Yard Sale; Security update with warmer weather don't leave unlocked doors unattended; Annual Picnic – RSVP # attending to Board@greenwayfields.org; New trees water twice a week, into fall and winter for first three years.

f. PIAC Funding

i. Request # 350549 for 78 locations; Blue Sidewalk tile replacement funded by the FY 18/19 PIAC for \$86K, GFNCID needs to contribute \$4K. Clem noted we need to watch other spending for FY 18/19 as the \$4K will come guickly in May to secure city funds.

g. Sidewalk replacements

- i. Bob E. / David T. have sidewalk list needing repairs. Clem estimated around \$7.50 sq/ft or \$90 per sidewalk panel. Total list of areas with repair estimates around \$23K.
- ii. Derek has checked with City and our neighborhood is priority 1 & 2 on the list, but unsure how long the list is.
- iii. Bob E. / David T. would like to know if GFNCID can commit funds to new PIAC request for FY19/20. I advised, and Derek is trying to get some direction if sidewalks should pull from "GO Bond" funding and not PIAC. If "GO Bonds" GFNCID should not cost share since it seems a double taxing to our residents.
- iv. Board will consider contributing funds (\$2k?) in FY18/19 to assist with funding prioritization for GFHA sidewalks.

h. Landscaping – Beth / Clem

- i. 13 trees planted by Soil Service, addressed a major heat island near 63rd / Summit.
- ii. Spring cleanup / mulching complete.
- iii. Benches ordered for Monkey Island pending delivery in May. Potential small rose garden could be installed on Monkey Island as well.
- iv. Statue placement pre-approved \$1,500 in March. Final costs will be \$1,900 to mount and finish final work. Crews are looking to complete mounting on Tuesday 4/17/18 to seal with dry weather. Clem motioned to approve the \$1,900 labor costs for final placement in the park, 2nd Joe, all in favor, motion APPROVED.
- v. Grass restoration at park exposed dirt. Needs addressed as too late to plant grass seed.
 - 1. Proposed placing sod on exposed dirt 1,740 sq/ft or 193 rolls of sod.
 - 2. Clem proposed direct order sod from farm tax exempt with delivery approx. \$700.
 - 3. Utilize Soil Service labor rate only to level dirt, power rake / cut in new sod with existing grass. Soil Service did not quote a price, but should be 4 labors at \$200/hr, for approx. 8 hours, or approx. total \$800. Soil Services can install on or near May 2nd.
 - 4. Watering will be additional \$200 per week for 3 weeks for total of \$600.
 - 5. Total proposed cost to sod exposed dirt would be: \$2,100. Major maintenance is very close with our improvement, recommended spend from the landscape budget with no other landscape improvements this year. Clem motions to approve, the approx. \$2,100 costs to sod exposed dirt in the park before summer heat, 2nd Scott, all in favor, motion APPROVED.
 - 6. Beth presented a suggested maintenance schedule for various park equipment, statuary, trees etc within and managed by GFHA. Long term maintenance plan will avoid major deferred maintenance issues and save money in
 - 7. Drain at 63rd and Pennsylvania has become clogged and is a big issue for neighbors. Beth will see if there's an existing 311 case with KCMO.
 - 8. David Thompson has been watering all the landscaping on Monkey Island. Clem motions to send David \$200 for watering costs. 2nd- Beth, APPROVED
