Building permits and teardowns:

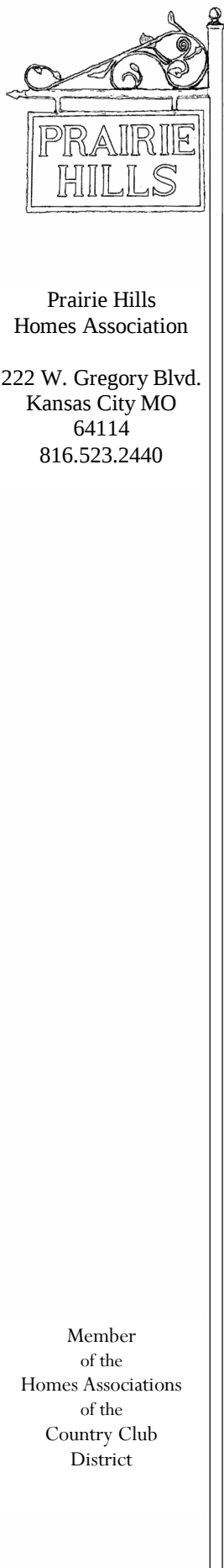
The Board would like to work with the city to get notification about building permits and teardowns so that they can be aware of issues that may impact the quality of home development in the city.
