Minutes of November 10: Marsha moved to approve the minutes of November 10 and Loring seconded the motion. The minutes were approved as written.

Treasurer's Report: A resident applied for a \$50 grant for a block party. It was moved by Wesley and seconded by Loring to approve the \$50 grant. There is \$5000 left in the budget. Twenty five hundred dollars is left for administrative costs. Loring reported that the board will be close to budget.

Annual meeting preparation: Last year's meeting was very successful with approximately 95 residents attending. The Cherokee Christian Church was an excellent location for the meeting. Two Guys and a Grill served breakfast. John will call the church and contact the food providers. Wesley will contact the magician this year since this was also a great success.
