<u>Treasurer report</u> - Marianne reported that we have a total of 4 CD's 2 of which are scheduled to mature in April. Her proposal is to renew one for 6 months and leave one for an additional year with the rationale that staggered dates give us flexibility for unplanned expenses. Motion made *to approve renewing one CD for 6 months, and the other for a year*. Motion passes.

Marianne has been monitoring home sales in PVHA area looking for homeowners with delinquent dues. Fox confirmed that if we let him know the homeowner owes us for delinquent dues, a lien will be filed, and we will be paid when the home is sold. The Realtor will let Fox know when a home is sold and the delinquent dues are added to the sale price. Question if debt is forgiven after 3 years as per bylaws – Does filing a lien with the county take care of it? Per Ron, the best way to handle is to leave the lien, and when the home is sold it will quiet title.

Board agreed that is it acceptable for Treasurer to advise to homeowners who inquire that they can make small monthly payments to avoid having a lien placed on their home.
