Fall Clean Up - Dumpster Day

The Armour Fields Fall Clean-Up day will be on Saturday,
Oct 13 between 8:00 am and noon.

Dumpsters will be set up a the usual site, on the "Cherub Island" at the intersections of Pennsylvania and 69th/69thTerr,

Two types of items will be accepted.

The first type is leaf and brush:

- Only leaves and brush are allowed in that dumpster.
- Yard debris may be loose, in paper bags or cardboard boxes, just not in plastic
- Tree limbs can be up to 10" in diameter and 6' in length.
- Please do not place plastic bags or trash in the dumpster. The State of Missouri does not allow leaves and brush in the landfill.

The second type is common household trash and debris.

Please do not place leaves and brush, tires, household hazardous materials or electronics in this dumpster.
