Greenway Fields Neighborhood Community Improvement District FAQ

Q: What is the status of Greenway Fields Neighborhood Community Improvement District ("GFNCID")?

A: GFNCID was established in October 2009.

Q: Why did I receive an assessment billing from Greenway Fields Homes Association ("GFHA") in January 2010 if GFNCID was established in October 2009?

A: While GFNCID was established in October 2009, it was too late for the GFNCID assessment to be included in your 2009 county tax bill. Therefore, you received a 2010 assessment billing from GFHA in order to pay homes association expenses (e.g., snow plowing, park landscaping and maintenance, etc.) incurred throughout 2010.


Q: When will I receive a GFNCID assessment billing?

A: You will receive GFNCID assessment billings annually on your county tax bill, beginning in late summer/fall of 2010 when you receive your 2010 county tax bill. In 2010, the GFNCID assessments will be collected to pay for homes association expenses to be incurred throughout 2011.

Q: Am I being billed twice for homes association assessments?

A: No. 2010 is an atypical year given the recent establishment of the GFNCID and its related timing. The January 2010 billing was for homes association expenses to be incurred during 2010 and you are paying GFNCID assessments at the end of 2010 as well. However, the GFNCID assessments being collected at the end of 2010 are for expenses to be incurred during 2011.

Further questions can be answered by the GFHA Board.

Notes From Pastor John Clifton of Wornall Road Baptist Church

he recent violent crimes in nearby neighborhoods remind us of the immense value of a safe community. Most of the people who attend our church live within a close distance to the recent crimes. Together we have determined to do all that we can to provide comfort and a sense of community to our neighbors. We want our community to know that we are praying for the security and peace of our neighbors. We have opened our building to the entire community every Thursday evening at 6:30 for a time of community prayer for the safety of our neighbors. You are welcome to come and share this time with us. We have information on selfdefense for women, as well as help with the installation of new locks and security issues in your home. We hope to do what we can to make Greenway Fields a better place.

Our church has recently become a hub of "caring" activities. We now host a Haitian church in our building. This wonderful group of 40 to 50 Haitians has suffered much in the recent earthquake. Most of the church members suffered the loss of a loved one to the disaster. (Their continued faith has been an inspiration to us.) We also host two other churches in our building, these churches are just forming and in the near future will launch out on their own to some of the more challenging parts of our city. Each week, through our partnership with Harvesters, we provide backpacks of food for eligible Border Star School children to take home over the weekend to ensure they have nutritious food to eat.

As we have grown in the past couple of

years, our building has been realizing some much needed improvements, most notably the total renovation of our steeple and the addition of a beautiful clarion, which plays each Sunday at noon and strikes at noon each other day of the week. As a part of the Greenway Fields community, we offer our building, free of charge, to any Greenway Field resident to use for a family gathering or other event. While we do allow people to rent our building for weddings, we have a special discounted fee for residents of Greenway Fields. Call our office at 444-8900 to learn more.
