

Architectural Committee News

Please remember that you need to complete and send the one-page Home Improvement Request for projects, which include fence replacements, to Tom Harrington at woden70@gmail.com or drop it by my home at 18502 W 114th St. Our committee needs to review roofing materials and color, fence height and materials, tree removal, satellite dish/antenna placement on the outside of structures, additions or modifications of decks or patio coverings, and other issues like above ground hot tubs and swimming pools. Northwood Trails on eNeighbors.com has this form and the seven pages of NWT Deed Restrictions. A fast way to access these is to click on "Northwood Trails" on the blue banner above the Bulletin Board tab, then scroll down to Public Documents.

Do you know the distinction between eNeighbors and NWT Facebook group? eNeighbors contains documents, a directory of registered residents, and other useful information. While in theory all 459 homeowners should be registered on eNeighbors, 418 are currently registered – the 41 who aren't registered show up as red dots on eNeighbor's Google Maps mashup. NWT Facebook group has 304 members with new members joining all the time. It's another useful resource for neighborhood information.

I check my email daily, and I look forward to reviewing your requests, with excellent help and advice from several former Architectural Committee chairs. Let's keep Northwood Trails looking great!
