FALL LEAF PICKUP PROGRAM TO RETURN SOON

After a trial run of the Prairie Hills Fall leaf program last year, the same landscaping company has agreed to provide this service again.

We'll offer two leaf vacuuming dates this year:

- The week of November 10th
- The week of December 1st.

You can sign up for one or both of these. The fee will be \$30 for one sweeping or \$55 for both dates.

You must register and pay in advance to have your leaves picked up. Look for the form in the center of this newsletter to sign up for this service. The deadline to sign up is November 5.

The first time you do anything you will make mistakes and learn from it. We learned that the city has a few guidelines for us to follow, as well as the landscape company. Here they are:

 Please make sure you rake your leaves to the edge of the yard but do not rake them into the street. It clogs storm drains and makes it hard for cars to pass.

- Make sure there are no sticks or branches in the piles. The equipment can't handle these.
- Taller and narrower piles are easier to pick up.
- If you have a sidewalk on your side of the street, please try to keep the leaves off the sidewalks.


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
