#### **LAWN AND GROUNDS REPORT**

**Lawn Services:** After 8 to 10 mowings and three lawn applications, TLC should be getting very familiar with our properties. Please be sure to provide feedback on the lawn services you are receiving to John Rudzinski, Lawn and Grounds Director so we can work with TLC to resolve issues and/or pass along your positive feedback.

**Lawn Mowing:** Weather permitting, **o**ur weekly mowing day is Friday. Back up day is Saturday. Please remember to unlock your gates and set your sprinkler systems to not water on Fridays.

**Lawn Application:** TLC will be applying Round #4 lawn application the last week of July or first week in August. This will be a "Grassy Weed Spray" with no fertilizer. Watch your message boxes for additional information.

**Pin Oak Iron Chlorosis:** This is a condition caused by a lack of iron in the tree that turns the leaves a pale green or yellow color, and the veins of the leaves will appear black. Check your tree. Walk around the entire tree because the color difference may be more noticeable on one side than on another. This change in color indicates your tree may have Iron Chlorosis and, if left untreated, may lead to branch die back or possible death of the tree.

There is a treatment for this condition that is far less expensive than cutting down a dead tree. Call Matt at <u>TLC</u>, 913-780-5296, and request an estimate. Mention you live in Westmont to receive a 20% discount. <u>Ryan Lawn Company</u>, 913-214-1447, will also give you an estimate to treat your Pin Oak.

Care for Your Outside Air Conditioner Condensing Unit: Check your condensing unit for cottonwood tree fuzz and grass clippings that may clog the unit coils and may cause condenser damage. Use your hose to give it a good spray all around to clean off. Also spray vigorously under the unit where debris settles. You needn't turn it off or cut the electricity. Service personnel do this all the time. If you can't do this easily, ask a neighbor to help or contact your service company. Thanks to our neighbor Don Niemackl for this solid, timely advice.

Waste Management Report: Please Recycle Responsibly: Waste Management has experienced more than 150 truck fires company-wide. Flammable items like batteries, paint thinners, gasoline, oil, or lighter fluid should not be tossed in a trash bin. A trash truck's compaction throughout the day punctures and crushes containers and batteries. All of those chemicals mingle together and can spontaneously erupt into fire. Serious injuries and property damage will result.

You can recycle hazardous materials at <u>Johnson County Hazardous Materials Collection Facility</u>. Since 1993, more than 250 tons have been safely disposed of.
